Pharr-San Juan's Boys & Girls Club has played a crucial role in minimizing mental health issues and the educational disparities exacerbated by the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The Hidalgo County Precinct 2 Boys & Girls Club of Pharr-San Juan Project Learn will help mitigate the negative impacts caused by the COVID-19 public health emergency to the Boys & Girls Club of Pharr-San Juan and help them develop a new program for their four locations called "Project Learn" which aims to reinforce the academic enrichment and school engagement of young people during the time they spend at the Boys & Girls Club.

Through this project, the Boys & Girls Club of Pharr-San Juan will be able to continue providing evidence-based interventions for Hidalgo's communities, especially those living in, near, and around Qualified Census Tracts (QCT) areas.
